You will be met in arrivals by your pilot who will be waiting to bring you by light aircraft, across this stunning landscape, before landing on a grass runway next to the Estancia.

Complete Luxury Estancia in the Argentine Wetlands

3 nights



The Esteros del Iberá are one of Argentina's hidden secrets, a vast swathe of wetlands and savannah, teeming with abundant animal life. One can see Caimans, capybara, deer, and over 400 species of bird (including Rhea – a large land bird) in this remarkable place.

This Estancia, originally built in the 18th Century, is part of a conservation project to protect the area with a resident biologist monitoring the area and the vast estate is allowed to grow wild, (apart from the immaculate gardens immediately surrounding the buildings).





The refurbishment of the estancia has been done with a remarkable attention to detail. Taps are antique French brass, and the beautiful wildlife prints and maps on the walls are all originals. A large garden supplies the kitchen with fresh organic produce and the meals are a delight, hearty country food with a contemporary edge. There is a special 'Quincho' (Barbeque outhouse) which is an event in itself.

Tours are tailor-made to your needs, with trips to the local lagoon (which you navigate by speedboat, stopping for a barbecue at sunset), light aircraft flights across the wetlands and trips across the savannah by Land Rover or on one of the 12 beautifully kept Criollo horses with an Argentine gaucho (cowboy).



The light aircraft remains at the Estancia during your stay and can be hired for further flights to the other two Estancias in this area.

Made up of some 275 separate falls that cascade over a precipice 3km wide Foz do Iguazu is, without question, one of the world's great natural wonders. Located on the border of Brazil, Paraguay and Argentina, their beauty and sheer magnificence really are indescribable. Previous visitors to the other great waterfalls of the world are consistently amazed by the sheer volume of water and consistently confirm Iguazu's reputation as the most impressive in the world. In 1986 UNESCO declared the falls a Natural Heritage of Mankind.

Tadeu will arrive to give you a walking tour of the Argentinean side before you board a powerboat to get up close to the falls to fully experience this amazing phenomenon.
